On Wednesday, 10<sup>th</sup> October 2018, a ceremony will be held in Dún Laoghaire to mark the centenary of the sinking of the RMS Leinster and to commemorate all of those who perished in this tragedy. The programme will comprise a significant cultural element as well as a formal commemoration and wreath-laying ceremony.

The Department of Culture, Heritage and the Gaeltacht is co-ordinating the arrangements for this event and is compiling a list of relatives and other interested parties who wish to receive an invitation to attend. This is a preliminary process to determine the anticipated number of invited guests and to help us to plan accordingly.

Please complete this Expression of Interest Form if you wish to receive an invitation to the official commemoration on 10<sup>th</sup> October. Invitations will be limited to two per person and are non-transferable. We will make every effort to accommodate all of those who request an invitation. Due to the geography of the venue, capacity is limited and submission of an Expression of Interest form does not guarantee that you will receive an invitation. It is envisaged that there will also be a designated public viewing area for attendees who do not have invitations.

The information that you provide on this form will only be used for the purpose of making arrangements for this ceremony and for the issuing of invitations.
